Know Ye that I the said Jn Hamond Do for the Love good Will and Affection which I have and bear to my neighbors of Westminster parrish in Ann Arundell County on the North side of Ann Arundell River have given and granted and by these presents do freely give & grant to the said? parrishioners of the aforesaid parrish Two hundred foot of Square Land out of my Dividend knowne by the Name of Deep Creek point for to Erect and build a Church house and Vestry house on? for the ? of the said parishioners to them? and their successors & for use pursuant to an Act of Assembly made the Eighth day of May Anno One Thousand Six-hundred Ninety five [four?] entitled an additional Act to the Act of Religion Royale Mmr? and the rents due to the chief Lord or Lords of the fee only excepted Alsoe? I give grant & ? all my right title and interest of the Aforesaid Land from me my? heirs? Executor? & Administator? assigns forever Absolutely without any mannor of condition Whereas I the said John Hamond ? have of? my hand and Seale? this Eighth day of February in the year of our Lord God One thousand Six hundred Ninety and Six
