The meeting of the Church Service League was held in the Parish Hall on Friday, July 8, 1927 at 8.00 p.m.

The Chairman, Rev. R. C. Bowling, opened with prayer after which the minutes were read and approved.

Mrs. Murray read report of the Pantry Club. Mr. Proskoy stated that the Church finances are at a low ebb and that on July 1st he would be unable to meet the current obligations. He asked for suggestions as to the best methods of raising sufficient amount to meet said obligations.

Suggestions for supper, birthday party, apron party + lawn fete were made. After a general talk

on the subject, it was decided, to have a lawn fete and dance. Motion made by Mr. Norris to have lawn fete and dance the following week. Motion seconded by Mrs. Murray and approved by all. Then followed a general talk regarding the details of the fete and dance.

Mr. Norris suggested that the financial condition of the church would be improved if a budget be prepared showing in detail, the general expenses of the church including payment on note. That this budget be made known to each member of the church in order that a more intelligent decision could be made as to the amount each member should give.
