

August 1931.

The regular quarterly meeting of the Church Service League of St. Margaret's which was held at the Parish Hall on Friday, Oct. 16<sup>th</sup> was opened at 8.15 p.m. with prayer by the Rev. R. C. Cowling, chairman.

The minutes of the January meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Cowling spoke on the importance of having an every member canvass this Fall, also on depression and what the world is facing at this time. He tried to impress upon the people the importance of attending the Church services and that it was the people he wanted and not the money.

Mr. Cowling suggested that we have a regular Parish supper to get the families together for a social gathering and at the same time make their pledges as a family instead

of having to be called on at their homes.

Mrs. John Murray made a motion to have a Parish supper in the Hall sometime in November to make pledges instead of having an every member canvass from house to house.

Seconded by Mr. C. C. Ridout.

General discussion followed.

Suggestion by Mr. George Norris to have services on Wednesday and Sunday evenings during the seven weeks of prayer and to have the supper and canvass at the close of that time.

Motion by Mrs. Proskay that every family bring a basket and spread lunch together and make coffee and chocolate at the hall to serve with supper.

Seconded by Mrs. Cowling and

approved by all.

The date and time set for the supper is Nov. 21<sup>st</sup> at 6.30 p. m.

As there was no further business a motion was made by the Chairman to adjourn which was seconded by Mr. Proskoy and approved by all. Adjourned at 9.30 p. m. after a very interesting meeting.
