Motion made by Mr. George Norris to appoint a house committee of three ladies and two gentlemen with Rector *ex officio*, to act as Chaperones on all entertainments in Parish Hall. Motion seconded and

approved by all.

Motion made by Mr. Morris that for any dance given after suppers or entertainments in Parish Hall, the amount to be used for music must not exceed \$6.⁰⁰ unless special permission be given by Vestry.

This motion seconded by Mr. Proskay and approved by all.
