The resignation of Mrs. Frank M. Duwall who has so ably held the Chairmanship of The Church Service League was accepted and a motion was made seconded and approved by all to appoint Mrs. George Norris as chairman of The Church Service League to succeed Mrs. Duwall.

Motion made and carried to adjourn at 10:15 P.M.
