county.

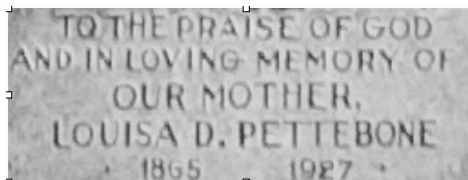
Pettebone Memorial Window

grandson.

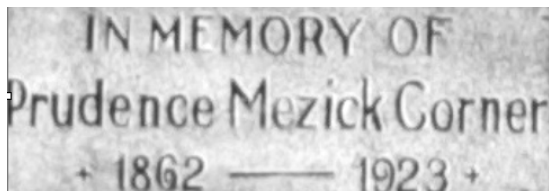


Corner Memorial Window

Unveiled March 3, 1929 by Irene Corner, granddaughter.

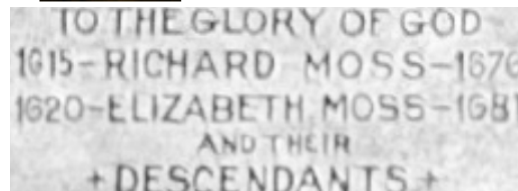


Moss Memorial Window

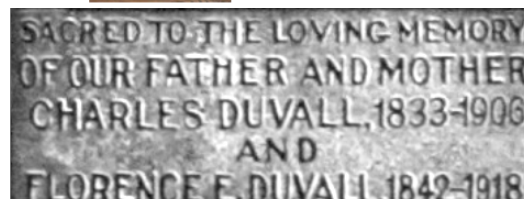
Duvall Memorial Window

Unveiled March 3, 1929 by Phyllis Dorsey, granddaughter



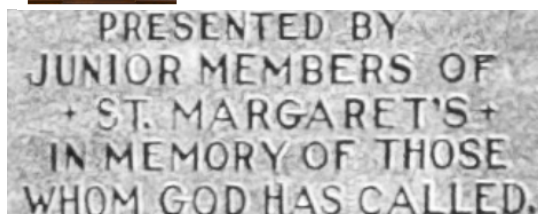
Junior Members Memorial Window

Unveiled March 3, 1929 by Olive Macey (1911-1994) president of the junior organization, and daughter of Oliver C. & Gladys Bauer Macey.



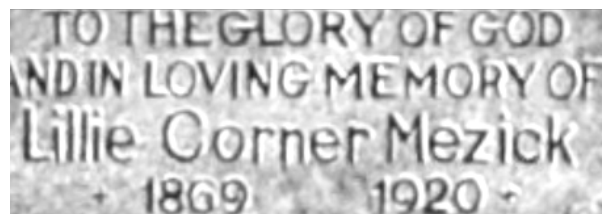
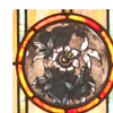
Mezick Memorial Window
